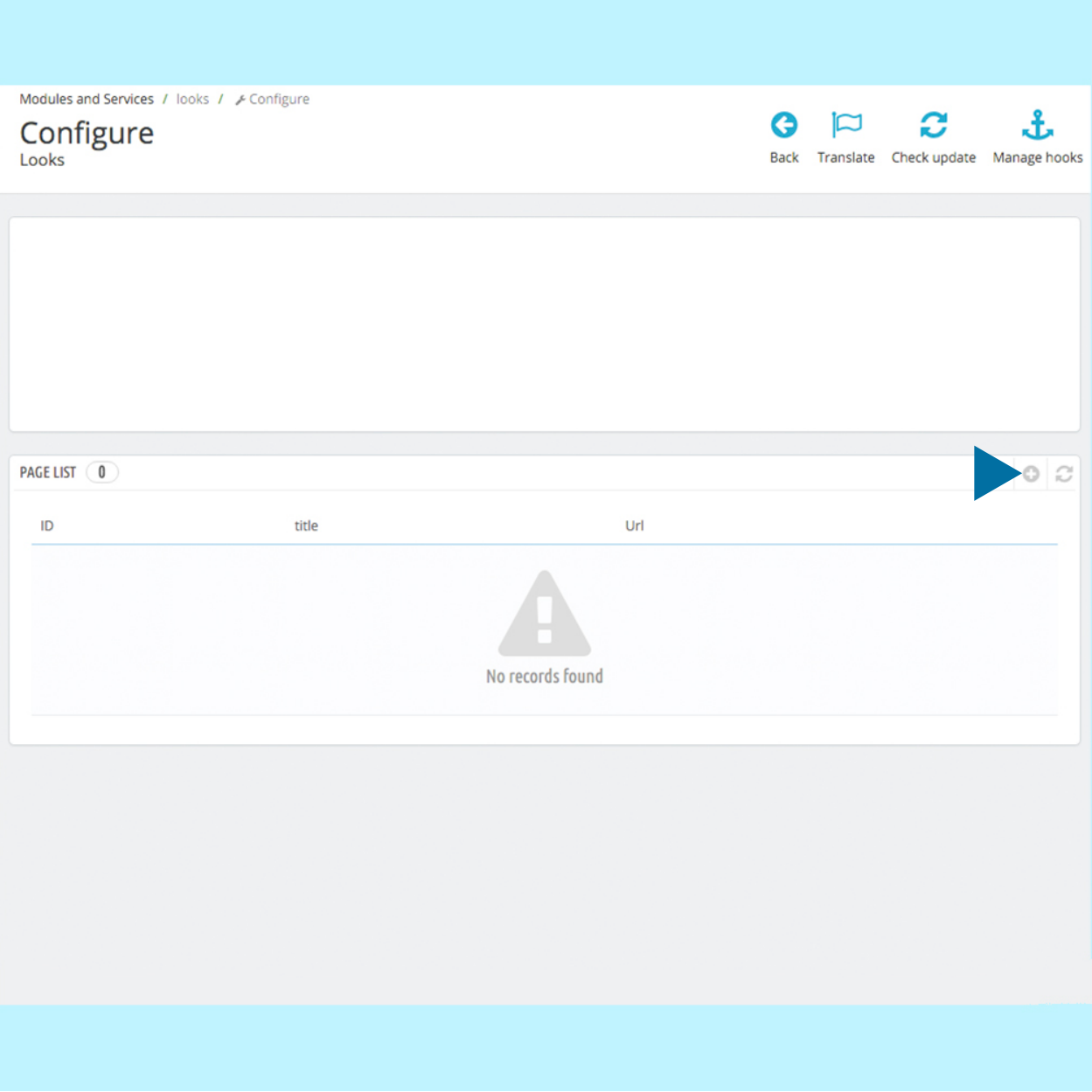

Once uploaded the image, its preview appears. Then you need to follow these steps:

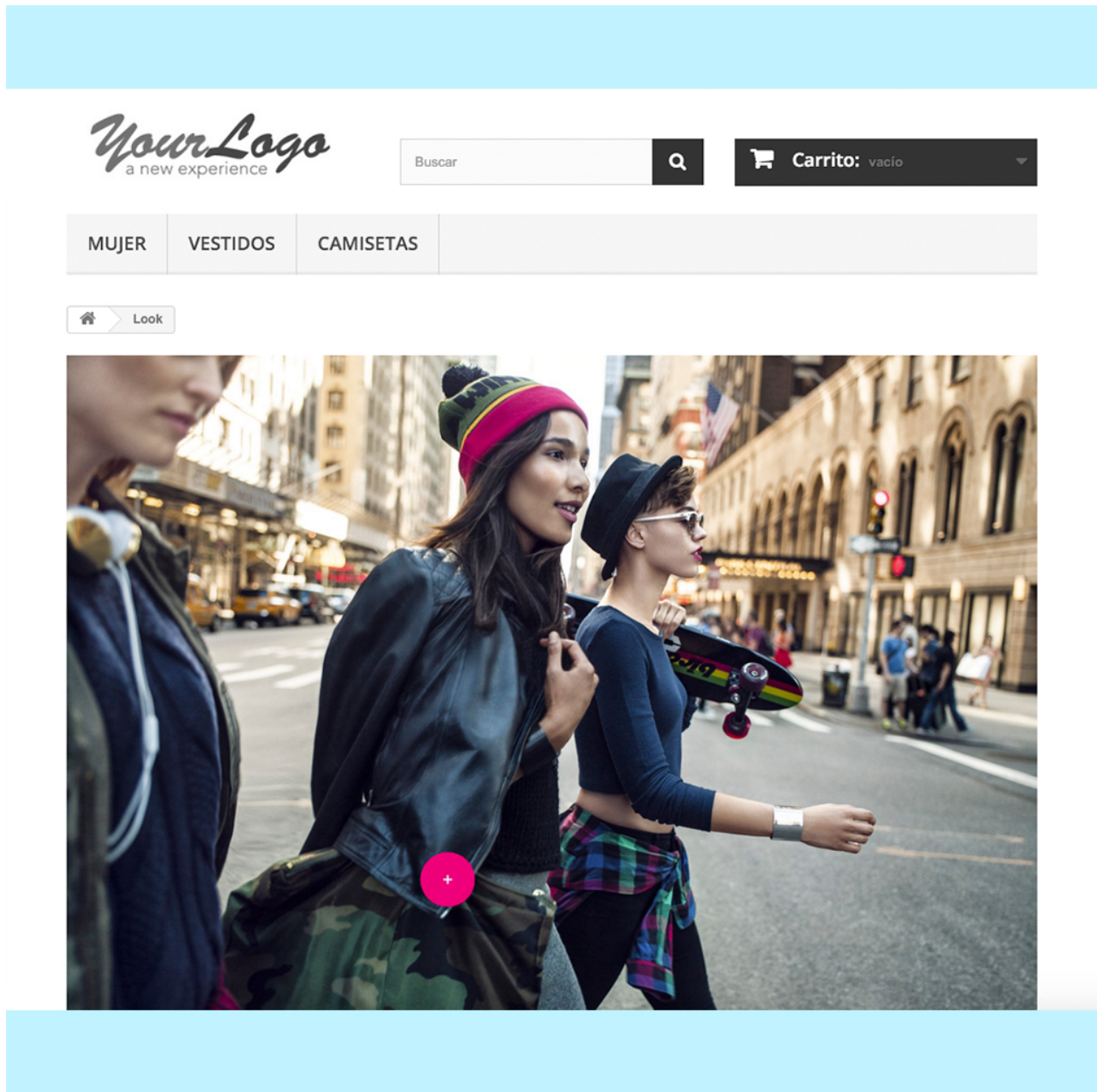
