Purpose and functionality

"Order validator" is a module developed by 4webs with the aim of allowing you to modify the statuses and validate the orders through a simple barcode scanning of each product, thus affecting your physical stock quantities.

Also, you can predetermine what order statuses you want to keep enabled or disabled for each employee.

On the other hand, you can also assign gifts to each product in your catalog, making the order appear as validated only when the EAN code of these gifts is also scanned or manually entered.

Start, in a fast and simple way, to automate your order validation processes in synchronization with your physical shop.



Installation and configuration


First, it is necessary to upload the module to the server. Later, you can find it in your module searcher and click on the option "Install". You can also access more quickly through the "Orders" section, in which you will find it integrated.

Next, a series of screenshots will be shown that will graphically explain the simple use and configuration of this module.

Once installed, look for "Order validator" in your list of modules and access its options through the "Configure" button, indicated in the image below.



Once inside the module configuration options, you can customize the aspects related to order statuses and employee permissions that are specified below:




- 1. If this option is enabled, the EAN codes of the gifts you assign to each product must be scanned or entered for the validation of the order. To know how to assign gifts to your products, see pages 6, 7 and 8 of this manual.
- 2. Select the order status in which the products of the same will be subtracted from your stock.
- 3. Select the order status in which the products of the same will be added back to your stock.
- 4. By keeping the status restrictions active for employees, you can select them at the bottom of this screen (points 5 and 6).
- 5. Select the employees to whom you want to restrict the states you mark to the right (point 6).

- 6. Select the states that you want to disable for the employees you have previously marked.
- 7. Save this configuration.



Next, we will proceed to explain the steps to follow to associate gifts to products individually:




- 1. First, go to the "Products" section, in the "Catalog" section of the side menu of your back-end.
- 2. Look in your list of products that you want to associate a gift with and click on the edit icon.

Within the configuration options of the product, go to the modules tab (point 1), look for the module "Order validator" in the list and press "Configure" (point 2).




Then, you can see the screen on which you will be able to associate gifts to the product you have selected, as shown below:




- 1. Determine the amount of gifts you wish to associate with the product.
- 2. Begin typing the name of the gift product. A list of options will be displayed in which you can select the one or the ones you want.
- 3. Save this configuration and there will already be the gifts associated with this product. So all orders that include this product must be also validated by inserting the EAN codes of their gifts.


To finish, you can change the status or validate your orders by scanning or inserting the barcodes of the products and gifts included in each of them. To be able to validate an order, you must access it by going to the "Orders" section of the side menu of your backend (point 1). Next, look in the list of orders that you want to validate or change status and press "View" (point 2).



As shown in the lower screenshot, the order statuses that have been restricted in the module configuration screen (see points 5 and 6 on page 5 of this manual), appear as disabled if accessed with the accounts of the defined employees.



In the lower part of the order, you will find the section "Order Validator", where you can manually enter the barcode of the products of this order, or scan them by POS:



- 1. Enter or scan the bar codes of the products of the order (point 3).
- 2. The validation log contains a record of each of the times that this order has been validated, the date and the employee who executed it.
- 3. List of products pending validation.

4. Once the products and gifts attached to this order have been validated correctly, this symbol will turn green.

This module does not modify any controller or intervene in any critical Prestashop process.
